

## Installing Firefox v52.8 on MacOS to use Topaz with Silverlight:

Go to the Applications Folder and delete the current Firefox application.

Go to <http://content.research.uconn.edu/pdf/uch/rits/topaz/Firefox52.8.0esr.dmg> to download a file (Firefox52.8.0esr.dmg) to your Downloads Folder.

**Double-Click** on the file (**Firefox52.8.0esr.dmg**). This will create a new removable disk on your desktop and open a window to allow you to drag the Firefox.app to the Applications folder. Once the copy has completed you can eject the Firefox removable disk.

Launch Firefox from your applications folder

Depending on your version of MacOS you may see the following message:

***“Firefox” can’t be opened because it is from an unidentified developer. or “Firefox.app” is an application downloaded from the Internet. Are you sure you want to open it?***

Click Open if that choice is available. Or Open System Preferences > Security and Privacy

Click on the General Tab > Look for a button that says Open Anyway

Firefox should now launch. If an import settings box comes up, choose Don't Import anything (bottom choice). For Default Browser select **"Not now"** and **unchecked** "Always perform this check when starting Firefox."

Go to **Tools** Menu at the top of the screen choose Add-ons (second choice).

Click **Plugins** in the left panel

You should see Silverlight in the Plugins list

Select **Always Activate** on the drop down menu to the right

Go to the **Firefox** menu next to the Apple logo at the top of the screen.

Click on **Preferences**

Click **Advanced** in the **left panel**

Click on **Update** in the **top panel**

Select: **Never check for updates (not recommended: security risk)**

***This will keep Firefox from automatically upgrading to the latest version and un-doing all of the previous steps.***

***Ignore any pop-ups asking you to upgrade to the latest version of Firefox. If Firefox is upgraded you will have to repeat all steps from the beginning to access Topaz again.***
